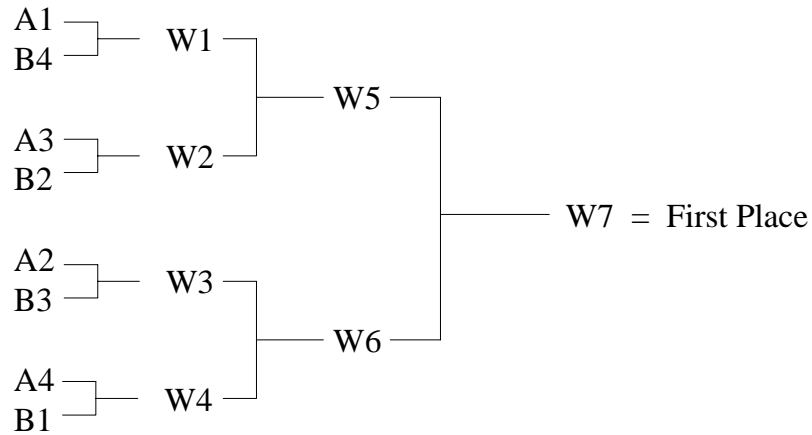


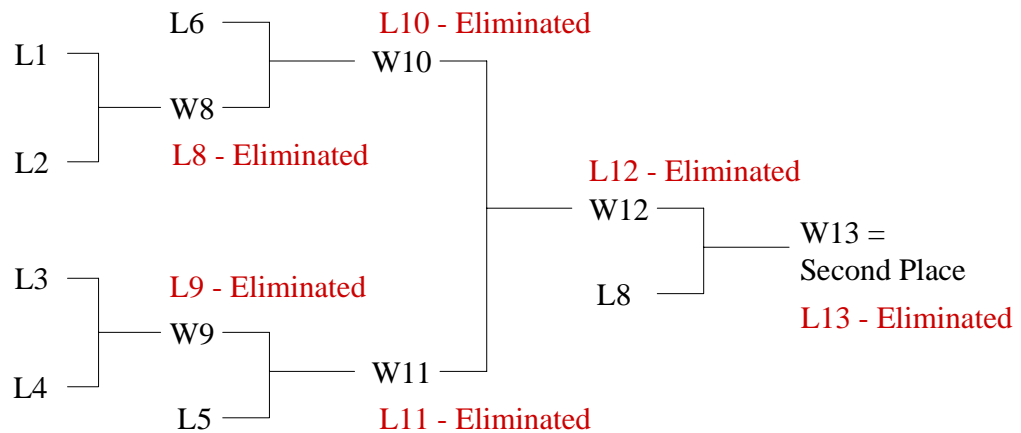
Billabong Double Elimination Tourney

Eight Teams A1-A4,B1-B4, actual team selection To Be Determined
We will probably have to start early, at about 3:00, to finish by 5:15.

Winner's Bracket



Loser's Bracket



To determine the winner of a match, both teams play twice, switching who moves first.

1. If a team wins twice, it moves to the next round.
2. If both players make obviously random moves, with no progress toward the goal, both players will be declared losers. The next round opponent will get a bye.
3. If both players repeat the same sequence of moves more than three times in a row the winner is the team with the fewest kangaroos remaining on the board. If the number of kangaroos is identical then the winner is the team whose kangaroos are closer to the finish line (sum of the distance to the finish for each kangaroo remaining).
4. If the teams split wins, the winner is the team that had the fewest kangaroos remaining on the board in their losing game (e.g. if A1 had 3 kangaroos left when it lost its game, and B4 had 1 kangaroo left when it lost its game, then B4 will advance to the next round).
5. If there is still a tie, the winner is the team whose kangaroos are closer to the finish line (sum of the distance to the finish for each kangaroo remaining) in their losing game.
6. If there is still a tie, the winner is the team that won in the fewest number of moves.
7. If there is still a tie, replay the games with half the amount of time per move.
