## **Fundamentals of Engineering (FE) Exam Procedures for Registering**

1. UAA does not administer the FE exam. However, the UAA School of Engineering offers a **FE Refresher course** to help you prepare for the exam. See <http://engr.uaa.alaska.edu/> for information about the refresher course.
2. You must **apply to take the FE exam** with the Alaska State Board of Registration for Architects, Engineers and Land Surveyors (AELS Board) at <http://www.dced.state.ak.us/occ/pael.cfm> and pay the application fee before the **DEADLINE** set by **AELS**. You will find the application, exam schedule and more information under the “Applicants & Registrants” header.
3. Also click on the AELS “Exam Schedule” link for application deadlines. The exam is given twice a year in April and October.
  - \* You must have 75% of your course work completed in order to apply. This is about **99** credits of the approximate 132 credits required for your degree.
  - \* If you add your name to the FE Exam log in the School of Engineering front office, we will send a confirmation letter to the State AELS Board verifying that you have completed 75% of your course work.
4. If your application has been approved by the State AELS Board, they will mail you a letter with instructions on how to **register to take the FE exam** with **ESLES, LLC**, the company who administers the exam. You will then register and pay the exam fee before the **DEADLINE** set by **ELSESES**. ***The ELSESES deadline is not the same as the AELS deadline.*** See <http://www.els-examreg.org/>.
5. Scores from the exam are mailed by the State AELS Board to you.
